Listowel to Atwood Rail Trail - This newly expanded, 11 mile trail takes you through a lush pine and juniper forest, providing a pleasurable year round experience along the former railway rights of way from the Kinsmen Trail south and the expanded trail to Atwood.

Atwood was settled as far back as 1854. In the early days, the town was known as 'Elma Centre' and 'Newry Station'. Settler John Binning Purcell was the first to arrive and created a permanent settlement in the area slightly to the north (now identified as the Town of Listowel). Atwood has always been known for its pioneering spirit. Today, it has grown into a charming residential community, mainly for people who work in the busy commercial centres of Kitchener, Waterloo, Guelph and Stratford.
